Please note that we are checking with our diocese as to whether we can offer this following program for fund-raising for El Hogar. Please watch for further confirmation.

Once again, the El Hogar service team will be working hard to raise funds to pay for the three sponsorships we take on for St. Luke's. We do this by making gingerbread replicas of St. Luke's or houses, several varieties of delicious chocolate bark, selling Marilyn Barnes' beautiful greeting cards, and this year, Honduran coffee either beans or ground.

Rony, Victor and Yeferson pictured below, depend on our support so we hope that we can count on the support that you have always so generously given us in the past.

Due to constraints because of Covid-19, we will be doing a pared-down and limited version of our usual fundraising. **All orders will be on a pre-ordered basis only.** Covid-19 is not passed along through food so our products are safe. Our volunteers will follow all health protocols to remain safe.

We will be offering mostly gingerbread kits which will consist of preassembled structures, candy for decorating as a fun family project, and a tube of icing. Each kit will cost \$30 or two for \$55.

Our chocolate bark will be available in three delicious flavours – peppermint (white & dark chocolate), Skor Bar (dark chocolate), and Toasted Almond with Smoked Sea Salt (semi-sweet chocolate). All are made with the highest quality Belgian chocolate. The cost of each 100 gram package will be \$10 or four for \$35.
