Columbarium Construction Activity

No Parking and Restricted Use of Church Sidewalks
Monday, Oct 4, through to Tuesday, Oct 12

Weather permitting, starting Monday, Oct 4, Calibre Concrete will be excavating for a foundation for the 2 new columbaria and constructing reinforced concrete bases.

There will be No Parking at the entrance at 1371 Elgin St and during weekdays walking through the church area sidewalks will be extremely restricted due to the presence of heavy machinery.

For those using the Parish Hall during this time it is suggested that you approach only from the Ontario Street entrance.

This construction is planned to be finished on Tuesday, Oct 12 if all goes well.
Delivery and installation of the columbaria is tentatively scheduled for later in October.
